(Jackson, MS) Hinds County District Attorney Jody E. Owens, II, announces the guilty verdict in the trial of Antrez Davis who was found guilty of Attempted Auto Burglary.

On July 9, 2022, an officer with the Jackson Police Department (JPD) was stationed in an unmarked vehicle at the Jackson Post Office located at 1501 Jacksonian Plaza conducting surveillance as part of an investigation into recent auto burglaries in the area. During his surveillance, the officer observed three male subjects pulling car door handles in the parking lot. Before the officer could radio for backup, Davis approached his vehicle and pulled the handle on the driver's side door. Davis was apprehended along with one of his accomplices. JPD recovered a firearm as well as other evidence from the immediate area.

Following a 3-day jury trial, Davis was found guilty of Attempted Auto Burglary. Davis is scheduled to be sentenced on February 27, 2024. Pursuant to Mississippi law, Davis faces up to seven years in prison.

Today's verdict is just one example of how we are working to address property crime in Jackson" DA Owens said following the verdict. "By working with and supporting JPD and our other law enforcement agencies to address property crime, we are improving the quality of life in our communities."
