## State v. Terrance Longino

(Jackson, MS) Hinds County District Attorney Jody E. Owens, II, announces the guilty verdict convicting Terrance Longino of First-Degree Murder. Longino was convicted following a five-day trial, in the Circuit Court of Hinds County.

On July 7, 2018, JPD Officers responded to a shooting at the intersection of Eastview and Central Street where they discovered the body of 26-year-old Lee Evans. At trial the evidence supported that Longino shot multiple into Lee Evans' body over an alleged theft of a broken iPhone and \$30.00.

Longino faces life in the custody of the Mississippi Department of Corrections. Sentencing is scheduled for today at 1:00p.m.

"This is another act of senseless violence, our office is committed to holding those who commit these acts accountable", says District Attorney Owens
